

Morning turtle census

At 5:00am we monitor the beach to record all night activity, sometimes we miss some turtles at night. You can be part of the day census and have the privilege to witness the evidence of the nesting turtles such as turtle tracks and numbers of nests laid. And to see the sunrise in the caribbean.



Established time

the day census takes place at 5:00 am and is subject to the carrying capacity of the beach and climatic conditions.

Considerations

After June you might have the opportunity to see hatchlings and if you are very lucky to see a female nesting during the day

Packing list

Comfortable clothes for walking, closed shoes, bottle of water, camera and sunscreen.

Walk 6km on beach.
