

# Daytime - Forest Hike

Facilitator: Pacuare Reserve staff



Hike the trails of the rainforest to observe a large diversity of amphibians, birds, primates, mammals, arthropods and plants.

## Time

Variable, depending the daily logistics of the Reserve and the carrying capacity and climatic conditions.

## Packing list

Long sleeves, long pants, rubber boots or closed shoes, bug spray, rain jacket/cape, hat, sun screen, water bottle, binoculars and camera.

## Considerations

The day hikes are offered by a staff member who will accompany and orient the group on the trails. There are no inclines on the trails; however, the difficulty will depend on the speed of the hike. We therefore recommend that participants take their physical condition into consideration before exposure to high temperatures, high humidity and the presence of insects such as mosquitos. If you hope to learn more about the species natural history and how to identify them we recommend you to go with a naturalist guide with prior reservation.
