



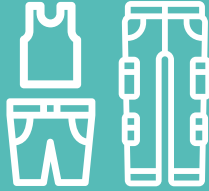

# PACUARE RESERVE PACKING LIST

Dark and long-sleeved shirts to participate in nocturnal censuses or walks in the forest



Light and fast drying clothes (avoid jeans)



Sunscreen 30FPS or more



Personal medications



A small backpack for the censuses and hikes



1 waterproof layer and boots



1 pair of shoes for the censuses and hikes



Flashlight or headlamp (only to be used in the station and NOT in the censuses)



Deodorant, brush, toothpaste, soap, towel, etc.



1 pair of sandals



1 hat or cap



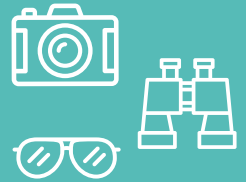
Water bottle
