

PACUARE RESERVE PACKING LIST

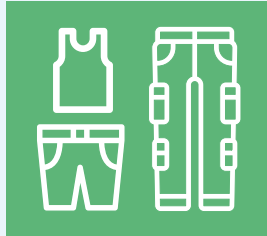

A small backpack for the censuses and hikes



Dark, long-sleeved shirts to participate in nocturnal censuses or walks in the forest



Light and fast drying clothes (avoid jeans)



1 pair of shoes for the censuses and hikes



1 waterproof layer



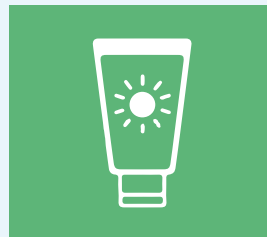
1 hat or cap



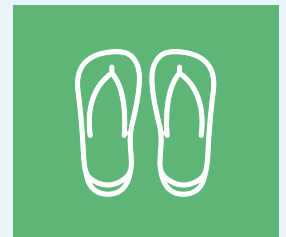
Personal medications

1 pair of sandals



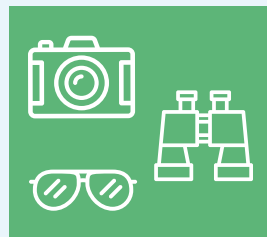
Mosquito repellent
