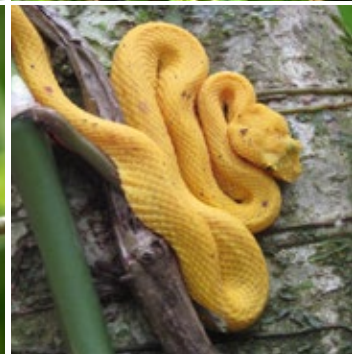
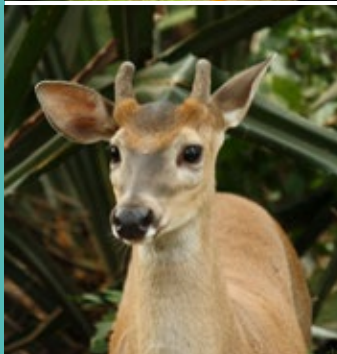


Wildlife hike

Facilitator: Naturalist Guide

A certified naturalist guide will accompany you along the trails of the rainforest, where you can hear the ocean waves and the sounds of the jungle, while you learn about the natural history of a variety of birds (which may be the rare Agami heron depending on the season), primates, arthropods, reptiles and flora.



Time

Variable, depending the daily logistics of the Reserve and the carrying capacity and climatic conditions.

Packing list

Long sleeves, long pants, rubber boots or closed shoes, bug spray, rain jacket/cape, hat, sun screen, water bottle, camera, binoculars.

Considerations

There are no inclines on the trails; however, the difficulty will depend on the speed of the hike. We therefore recommend that participants take their physical condition into consideration before exposure to high temperatures, high humidity and the presence of insects such as mosquitos.

Duration

On average 1 hour and 30 minutes.

Cost

Minimum 2 pax - \$40 pp
3 and more - \$30 pp

Length

Los Pumas trail: 2.6 km
Wakefield trail: 1 km
Agami trail: 2 km
