

Workshop on local crafts: become an artist for a day

During this workshop you will learn traditional techniques to create crafts made of natural materials such as coconut shells, bones, yolillo palm tree seeds and others; all of different textures, hues, and hardness. Your teacher, Maritza, has been creating these kinds of crafts for over 12 years in the local region of Barra Pacuare. She will guide you step by step through the process of creating your own, unique piece and tell you about local culture and the significance of the materials. You will not only leave with your own, unique piece of jewelry but with a piece representing local, Caribbean culture.
