Be ready to live a unique experience from the moment you get on board our small boat at the dock: you will be surrounded by an evergreen landscape and a vast ecosystem full of aquatic life; which you will feel close up thanks to the sounds of the birds, the reflection of the trees on the water and the essence of the jungle that turn the route into an experience of natural aromatherapy. You will also have the opportunity to see many species of local flora and fauna; such as the howler, spider and white face capuchin monkeys, alligators, herons, crocodiles, turtles and more.

Time
